



# SUPERNAL 5 HI/LOW ADJUSTABLE BEDS OPERATING MANUAL

SAVE THIS MANUAL FOR FUTURE USE.

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#### 1 SAFETY

The safety statements presented in this chapter refer to the basic safety information that the operator of the Supernal 5 Bed shall pay attention to and abide by. There are additional safety statements in other chapters or sections, which may be the same as or similar to the following, or specific to the operations. Please note the following special statements, used throughout this manual, and their significance:

- ▲ NOTICE: Indicates a potential hazard or unsafe practice that, if not avoided, could result in product or property damage.

Info: Provides application recommendations or other useful information to ensure that you get the most from your product.

#### **WARNING / CAUTION / NOTICE SUMMARY**

WARNING: To Reduce the Risk of Burns, Fire, Electric Shock, or Personal Injury:

- **⚠ WARNING:** Keep hands and feet clear of all moving parts.
- **⚠ WARNING: DO NOT allow small children on or near bed during operation.**
- **⚠ WARNING: DO NOT** allow this device to be operated by small children.
- ⚠ WARNING: When operating the hi/lo, knee, or back function of the bed, ALWAYS ensure that the individual confined to the bed is positioned properly within the confines of the bed. DO NOT let any extremities protrude over the side or between the bed rails when performing any functions.
- - Ensure that body weight is evenly distributed over the surface of the bed. Do not lie, sit or lean in such a way that your entire body weight is placed only on the raised head or foot sections of the bed. This includes when assisting the user in repositioning or transferring in or out of bed.

**NOTICE:** To Reduce the Risk of Product or Property Damage:

- ▲ NOTICE: The pendant hand control cord must be routed and secured properly to ensure that the cord does NOT become entangled and eventually severed during use.
- ▲ NOTICE: When using nasal or masked type administering equipment, oxygen or air tubing MUST be routed and secured properly to ensure that tubing does NOT become entangled and eventually severed during normal operation of bed.

#### 2 INTRODUCTION, SUPERNAL 5 BED USER MANUAL

This manual contains assembly and maintenance instructions for your Supernal 5 Hi/Low Adjustable Bed System. Read the entire manual carefully before using your bed, and refer to it during use if you have questions.

#### **3 SAFETY NOTES**

This product complies with all relevant safety regulations.

Please read this documents carefully before using the bed for the first time. It contains important information on the use and safety of the bed.

- **⚠ WARNING:** The manufacturer does not accept liability if these instructions are not followed.
- ⚠ WARNING: This base is designed for in-home use ONLY. It is not approved for hospital use and does not comply with hospital standards. DO NOT use this base with tent type oxygen therapies or near the use of explosive gasses.
- ▲ NOTICE: The duty cycle for the motors is 2 Min. ON / 18 Min. OFF. In the event that the motors are operated excessively, they will automatically shut off. They should restart again normally after 20 minutes. This is a safety mechanism that is built into the motors.


- ⚠ WARNING: The motors, control box and Hand Control (except to replace batteries) are NOT to be opened or serviced except by those authorized by the manufacturer.
- ▲ NOTICE: Be careful that the power cord is not left in a place where the mechanism or any other factor can cause it to be damaged.

#### **4 UNPACKING THE BED**

The Supernal 5 Hi/Low Adjustable bed arrives mostly assembled in 1 box.

#### Before you unpack the bed:

- Ensure all parts/components are included.
- Check all bed components for obvious damage.
- Inspect the Power Cord for cuts or damage.
- Ensure all actuator motor cables are routed and connected properly to the control box.





## Discard:

- Foam Block
- Bubble Wrap
- Shipping Board
- Cable Tie Cut and Discard
- Delivery Box





#### Keep:

- Mattress Retainer
- Hand Pendant (and Batteries)
- Retainer Bracket
- Mounting Hardware
- Mattress Cover
- Any Accessories Ordered


If there is ANY shipping damage to your bed, notify customer service at, 770-368-4700 IMMEDIATELY. **DO NOT** attempt to build bed with broken or missing parts.

#### **5 ASSEMBLY**

When handling components of the bed, use work gloves to protect your hands. Keep mattress off of the bed while you are assembling the bed. Remove base from box and place it upside down on the floor. Make sure hand pendant is in safe area so as to not get damaged when turning base deck over. Attach retainer bar and half rails (if applicable). Turn bed over and place mattress on top.

#### **Headboard Installation (Optional Accessory)**

- 1. Locate rectangular tubes underneath the head section of the bed (right).
- 2. Insert headboard mounting tubes (right) into rectangular tubes, U-shape goes around upholstery. (Circled end goes into tubes).
- 3. Insert included screw in hole on each tube to jam headboard tube in place.
- Slide headboard brackets into headboard mounting tubes



#### **Retainer Bar Assembly**

**Packed Retainer Bar** 



There is one mattress retainer bar on each bed. This retainer bar keeps the mattress in place when adjusting bed positions. Locate the mattress retainer bar (zip-tied to the bed deck in delivery).

- 1. Using Phillips-head screwdriver, remove the (pre-installed) bolts from the deck boards.
- 2. Position retainer bar over pre-existing holes and place mounting hardware through retainer into holes.
- 3. Place bolts (provided) into mounting hardware and tighten with screwdriver.
- 4. Flip bed deck over and you are now ready to place mattress on the bed.









The assembly of the Supernal 5 Bed System is now complete. Connect the powercord to a nearby outlet and enjoy your new bed!

#### **Bed Rails**

#### **Bed Rail Safety**

Please read and understand the following bed rail decal before use:



BEWARE OF SIDE-RAIL ENTRAPMENT

Patient Entrapment with bed side rails may result in serious injury or death. ALWAYS evaluate patients for and guard against bed rail entrapment in accordance with medical protocols.

Monitor patient frequently. Mattress MUST fit bed frame and side rails snugly to prevent entrapment. There may be an increased risk of entrapment when bed rails are used in conjunction with low air loss products. Follow the Safety Warnings and Operating Instructions in the Service/User's manual. #### **Bed Rail Installation**

- 1. Bed base deck must be flipped upside down. Locate the 4 pre-drilled holes on the bed deck.
- 2. Remove all 4 pre-threaded bolts. Carefully align the bracket over the pre-drilled holes (as shown right).
- 3. Tighten all four bolts.
- 4. Place half rail into bracket and clip into holding place.

#### 7 OPERATION

Plug the power cord into any grounded outlet.

**⚠ WARNING: DO NOT leave the bed unattended when plugged in.** 

#### **SUPERNAL 5 HAND PENDANT**

All motorized functions of the bed are controlled by the remote control hand pendant.

#### Backrest Tilt

Press this button to lift up the backrest. Keep the button pressed and release when the desired tilt is achieved.

Press this button to lower the backrest. Keep the button pressed and release when the desired tilt is achieved.



#### Trendelenburg/Reverse Trendelenburg

Press this button on left side of hand pendant to raise the foot bed end. The head end will remain in the low position (Trendelenburg Position).

Press this button on right side of hand pendant to lower the foot end of bed. The head end will remain in the high position (Reverse Trendelenburg Position).



#### Footrest Tilt

Press this button to lift up the footrest. Keep the button pressed and release when the desired tilt is achieved.

Press this button to lower the footrest. Keep the button pressed and release when the desired tilt is achieved.



Press this button to lift up the bed. Keep the button pressed and release when the desired height is achieved

Press this button to lower the bed. Keep the button pressed and release when the desired height is achieved.



#### **Vibrate Function**

Press this button once to start vibrations. Second and third press increases the intensity of the massage in two steps.

To stop the massage, press multiple times until the massage comes to an end.

▲ NOTICE: The vibrate function will automatically shut off after 30 minutes to prevent unintended long term operation of the motors.

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#### 8 TROUBLESHOOTING

#### IF the bed does not operate at all.

- Ensure the bed is connected to power and the green indicator light on the top of the power supply is on.
- Ensure the batteries in the remote control are charged. If the batteries are discharged, they need to be replaced (see below).

#### IF a single function of the bed does not work.

Ensure all cable connections are firmly attached.

#### IF the remote control does not work.

- Ensure the protective plastic strip is removed from the battery compartment.
- **⚠ WARNING:** The bed's electronic system contains no serviceable parts. DO NOT open the motors, cables, or pendant hand control. Only a Graham-Field authorized distributor or factory-trained personnel may perform service or adjustments on these components.

#### 9 LIMITED WARRANTY

#### **SCOPE OF WARRANTY**

GF Health Products, Inc. ("GF") warrants to the Original Purchaser only that it will replace or repair components, at GF's sole discretion, that are defective in material or workmanship under normal use and service. All warranties are conditioned upon the proper use of the products strictly in accordance with good commercial practice and applicable GF instructions and manuals, including proper use and maintenance. To the extent that a third party warrants a component, GF conveys all of its rights under that warranty to the Original Purchaser, to the extent permitted. Original Purchaser is one who purchases this product new and unused from GF or a Certified GF Dealer/Distributor.

This limited warranty shall only apply to defects that are reported in accordance with the provisions set forth in this warranty document, within the applicable warranty period and which, upon examination by GF or its authorized representative, prove to be a warranty item. (See Obtaining Warranty Service below) This limited warranty is not transferable.

The warranted components and time periods are set forth below:

- \* Labor for the first year is included if the product is sold to an original consumer purchaser only. In all other situations, the warranty is for parts only.
- Upholstery is only warranted on material supplied by GF.
- If a part is replaced under warranty, the original warranty period will not be affected. All other replacement parts will be subject to the 90-day warranty period specified.

The applicable warranty period shall commence from date of shipment to the Original Purchaser, unless there is an expiration date on the component in which case the warranty shall expire on the earlier of warranty period or the expiration date.

#### **OBTAINING WARRANTY SERVICE**

Contact the Dealer/Distributor from whom the product was purchased. If there is not a Dealer/Distributor, you must contact GF directly by calling (770) 368-4700 or by e-mailing a request to cs@grahamfield. com. The Customer Service Representative will provide specific directions. Failure to abide by the specific directions will result in denial of the warranty claim.

The warranty does not cover and GF shall not be liable for the following:

- 1) Defects, damage, or other conditions caused, in whole or in part, by misuse, abuse, negligence, alteration, accident, freight damage, tampering or failure to seek and obtain repair or replacement in a timely manner;
- 2) Products which are not installed, used, or properly cleaned and maintained as required in the official manual for the applicable product;
